500th Beacon u3a

In early December we will be announcing the 500th u3a to implement the Beacon membership system. This is a fantastic achievement. Beacon is supported almost entirely by around fifty u3a volunteers. As one of our 500 u3as said, "We started using Beacon during lock down and it has made life so much simpler for the committee. Members can keep their details up to date via the Portal and authorised users are able to send out emails to all members in a few clicks, enabling us to keep in touch more often. Having proved the worth of Beacon for membership data storage and security, we look forward to expanding our use of further functions of the system over the coming year".

We offered this to Group Co-ordinators in May. In October, a similar meeting was offered to Business Secretaries and anyone who was interested in the role. These members were also asked to suggest any other topics that they would like to raise. There was quite a range which included clarification of the role, producing minutes, reporting to the Charity Commission and u3a constitutions.
